




Gobbler Age Distribution of Harvest






Regional Harvest - 15 Years

 - Season length was 14 days shorter in 2021 & 2022

Take Home Message

- 2022 spring turkey season was down 9% from 2021
 - Lower than the 5-year avg. by 10%
- 2-week delay does not appear to hurt early harvest #s
- Additional data being collect
 - Hunter harvest survey obtaining effort data
 - Harvest rate study (gobbler banding project)
 - Values and opinion surveys to inform regional-based management approach





Regulation Changes

- Season pushed back 2-weeks statewide (except where already 2weeks delayed)
- Bag limit dropped to 2 statewide
 - Only 1 can be a jake
- Fanning (or reaping) prohibited on WMAs
- Some WMA-specific changes
 - New quota areas (2 WMAs)
 - 1st 14 days, 1-bird limit (5 WMAs)

Fanning/Reaping

Fanning/reaping is defined as:

hunting or stalking wild turkeys while holding or using for hunter concealment any of the following items: a tail fan, a partial or full decoy with a tail fan, or a tail fan mounted to a firearm. Tail fans include those made of real or synthetic feathers or an image or likeness of a tail fan applied to any material.





Middle Tennessee Wild Turkey Research Project







- Final field season of study
- Finishing 1-year extension to investigate season timing impacts
 - Sampled hunter-harvested birds for disease surveillance
 - >140 samples collected (much better coverage this year!)



Gobbler Banding Project











- 2nd year of 4-year project
- 384 Birds banded in 2 years
 - 178 in 2021; 206 in 2022
- 107 Bands recovered in 2 years
 - 41 in 2021; 66 in 2022

Banding Sites





- 46 total sites (30 private; 16 public)
- UT wild turkey project also banded birds

2-Year Banding Results




384 Total Gobblers Banded

- 222 Adults; 162 Jakes
- 273 Regular bands; 111 Reward bands



2-Year Band Reporting



- 107 Total bands reported (28% reporting rate)
 - 85% Adults; 15% Jakes
 - 60% Regular bands; 40% Reward bands
